WHAT DO YOU KNOW ABOUT AL QURAN?



1. Al-Furqan, Al-Kitab, Al-Zikr, An-Noor and Al-Huda are some of the other names of the Quran that are stated in it.

2. The first revelation is the surah Al-Alaq : ayat 1-5. It takes place at the Hira' cave in Mecca.

3. The duration of the Quran being revealed gradually is 23 years. It started when Rasulullah was 40 years old during the first revelation until the time he passed away at the aged of 63.


4. The total amount of surah revealed in Mecca. is 86 surah out of 114.

5. The total amount of surah revealed in Medina. is 28 surah out of 114.

6. The total of sajdah verses is 15 across 14 surahs. Sajdah verses are the ayats in which it's a sunnah to perform sujud when it's read in the Quran.

7. Some things mentioned in the Quran is 'Tawhid to Allah, the universe, day of judgement, tales of the past ummahs, laws, morality and many others'.

8. The Quran is revealed from Luh Mahfudz to Baitul Izzah and then to Rasulullah little by little through the angel Gabriel (Jibril).

After Rasulullah s.a.w began to preach openly about Islam as commanded by Allah s.w.t, the Quraishi nobles strongly opposed this, going as far as implementing torture and then establishing an economic embargo upon the small muslim community for 2-3 years. Noticing the terrible suffering of his people, Rasulullah ordered his people to migrate to Habasyah. There were a total of 80 muslim migrants at the time.

THE BATTLE OF TABUK CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS

9 HURAH

This is a Test

At that time :

- (1) During the season of summer and bountiful fruits of all kinds
- (2) The Prophet received word that Rome was gathering about 40,000 troops
- (3) Then, the Prophet summoned Muslims to fight



The prophet orders of infaq as preparation for war was met by the sahabas r.a , among them saydina uthman with 300 camels and 100 dinars. Others such as Saydina Abu Bakr gave all his property for infaq.



As they arrived at the field of tabuk , the roman army never showed up for battle. Later on the muslim army received news that they have fled from battle. Consequently , a handful regions of rome sent their envoys to meet with the prophet requesting peace by paying jizyah.

A total of 80 munafiqun including Abdullah bin Ubai gave excuses and refused to answer the call to jihad. Unfortunately among those who refused the call was also some of the sahabah, Kaab bin Malik r.a.

Muslims face test and challenges :

- (1) Very long and difficult journey from medina to tabuk.
 - (2) the hot summer weather , the muslim army was dehydrated and exhaustion set in .
 - (3) Scarcity of food and water supply , forced the muslim army to slaughter some of their camels for food .
- However the prophet's mukjizat brought ease to the muslim army, as scarce food and water supply suddenly became plentiful for everyone

The story of those who DID NOT PARTICIPATE IN GHAZWAH TABUK

1



When the call to jihad was made, everyone was preparing themselves except Kaab bin malik.

2



When he was left behind in medina he was shocked and saddened that only the munafiqun and the old men stayed.

3



Initially he thought of lying to avoid the anger of the prophet. However he felt uneasy and told the truth

4



After the muslim army and the prophet returned, the munafiqun as their usual self gave excuses for being absent. The prophet graciously forgave them.

5



Kaab bin Malik however met the prophet and told the truth. Stating that there was no obstacle nor excuses for him for being absent. That he did not join because he was delayed.

6



Thus the command of Allah came to boycott Kaab as punishment. Murarah ibn rabi' and Hilal ibn umaiah also received the same fate.

7



The world felt small as Kaab bin Malik was boycotted by everyone he loved. Suddenly came a letter from the enemy offering riches and status if he left Islam. Knowing in his heart that this was a test from Allah, he refused and burnt the letter.

8



On the 40th day, came the command for kaab to separete from his wife. Willingly obeying the command of Allah, he sent his wife back to her parents until came the next revelation.

50 days has passed, thus came the word of Allah that their repentance was accepted. The muslim community rejoiced by the news. Kaab was the happiest man for this is non other than a real victory for himself and the muslim community in Medina.

LIBERATION OF BAITUL MAQDIS

At the time of Caliph Umar Al Khattab

During the battle of Yarmouk, 41000 Muslim army defeated 7000 Romans. Thus allowing Baitul Maqdis to fall under the control of the Muslims.

In the days of the Abbasid Kingdom, 15 JULY 1099

The crusaders were able to capture Baitul Maqdis after 500 years of Islamic rule. Ibn Khaldun had stated that ;
"The Romans have been terrorizing Baitul Maqdis for a week, robbing, raping and burning homes. Upon counting the number of bodies splayed in the mosque, house and along the roads they were not more than 7000 people"

In the days of Salahuddin Al Ayubi, 27 REJAB 583 H , 15 OCTOBER 1187

Baitul Maqdis was liberated again by Salehuddin Al Ayubi after 60 years of christian rule.

Muslim army provided good service to prisoners. No one in the city of Jerusalem was killed. Captives were allowed to leave the city of Jerusalem by paying ransom according to their capabilities

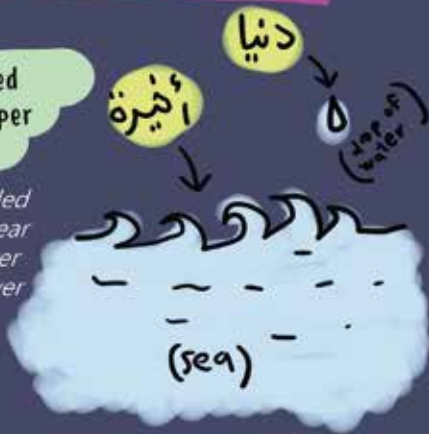
Whoever recite the Quran will be rewarded by Allah as stated by the prophet:

But the reveal of the Qur'an **is not just to read it.**

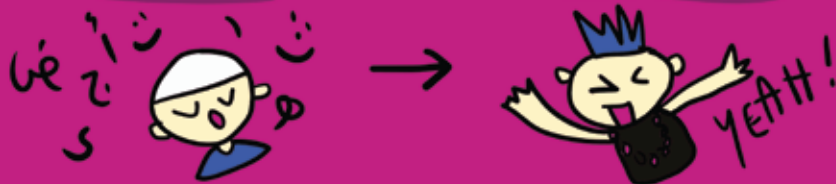
Quran acts as the guide to be followed and practiced by man in order to prosper in this world and hereafter.

FATHU MAKKAH

8 Hijrah

10000 strong muslim army marched from madinah to makkah to liberate the city. There was no bloodshed. However all the idols surrounding kaabah were destroyed as a result.



Cause of the battle : The hudaibiyah treaty was broken by the quraisy when bani bakr (ally of quraisy) attacked bani khuza'ah (a muslim ally). Thus the 10 year peace treaty signed between the quraisy and muslim was voided.

17th Ramadhan 2 Hijrah

THE BATTLE OF BADR

The muslim army choose a strategic location by controlling the water resources there. This battle involved 313 members of the Muslims army against 1000 Quraisy. In this war, the Muslim won the battle.

KHALID BIN WALID DESTROYED THE IDOL OF AL 'UZZA

After the Muslims liberated the city of Mecca, the Prophet Muhammad sanctified it by destroying 360 statues around the Ka'abah. The Prophet sent Khalid Al Walid to destroy the statue of Al 'Uzza which is the greatest statue on the goddess there. After that, the worship of the statue ended.

SUBMISSION OF TAIF CITY

The city of Taif and its people were previously known by driving out the prophet with stones from their village years earlier. After the Muslim forces successfully liberated Makkah, the Taif people were unwilling to accept the prophet and submit to Islam. The Muslim army put a siege on the city for a long time, which finally resulted in their surrender and consequent submission.

THE JOURNEY TO TABUK

Several wars had occurred in Tabuk on the month of Rejab, 9th Rejab. Muslim army left for Tabuk in the month of Rejab and returned to Madinah in the month of Ramadhan. This battle lasted 50 days including the journey to Tabuk and from Tabuk to Madinah.



THE SPREAD OF ISLAM TO YEMEN

Ali bin Abi Talib had been sent to Yemen. In a period of one day, all of them embraced Islam. This historical event occurred in the month of Ramadhan during the 10th year of Hijrah.

THE FALL OF BAITUL MAQDIS

13 Syaaban 492 Hijrah

In the First Crusade, the Christian Army seized Baitul Maqdis from the muslims and occupied the city. However, the city was succeeded by the muslims a few decades later.

Historical Events In the Month of Shawwal

1. THE BATTLE OF UHUD

Shawwal 3 Hijrah



Occurred due to the shameful defeat of the Quraishy army against the small muslim army in the previous battle of Badr. The Quraish wanted revenge.

1. The muslim army made a mistake when the archers upon the hill of Uhud disobeyed the order of the Prophet to hold the mountain.

2. There were 70 martyrs in the battle of Uhud, among them Saidina Hamzah.

3. The Quraishy army wanted to deal a finishing blow to the muslims by launching an attack and to kill the prophet, however they aborted this plan, knowing full well that the muslim army was ready to strike back.

THE BATTLE OF BANI QAINUQA'

Shawwal 2 Hijrah



The Prophet decided to fight the jews, as they were hostile towards the muslims and had betrayed the pact and agreement made with them.

THE BATTLE OF BANI SULAIM

Shawwal 2 Hijrah

The prophet with an army of 50 men headed to qarqarah al-kadr to defeat the forces of bani sulaym and ghatafan.

4.

THE BATTLE OF KHANDAQ

Shawwal 5 Hijrah



The jewish tribe Bani Nadhir, had attempted to assassinate the prophet and was thus banished and purged from the city of Medina.

The muslim army, with the suggestion of Salman Al Farisi, had dug deep and wide trenches around the city of Medina

With Allah's help, a sandstorm swept the ahzab army and wrought havoc in their camps. The prophet also sent spies and were succesful in planting discord within the ahzab forces. With the growing discord and fatigue by the weather, they retreated.

5. THE BATTLE OF HUNAIN

8 Hijrah



I It is a battle fought between the Muslim army against the badwin tribe of bani hawazin and bani tsaqif.

II

Occurred after 2 weeks of the conquest of Mecca

III

This battle ended with an absolute victory in favour of the muslim army on top of successfully attaining plenty spoils of war (ghanimah)

THE BATTLE OF THAIF

Shawwal 8 Hijrah

The people of Bani Tsaqif who had fled went to seek refuge in the fortress of Thaif. The Prophet and the muslim army had pursued them and had surrounded the fortress. Putting it under siege for more than 20 nights.

The muslim army had implemented a new technology by using a catapult (manjanik) against the fortress of Thaif. Also used the battering ram to breakdown the castledoors of the fortress.

THE BIRTH OF ABDULLAH BIN ZUBAIR

Shawwal 1 Hijrah

The birth of Abdullah ibn Zubair, and he was
the first infant of the muhajirin who was
born prematurely at 1 Hijriyah

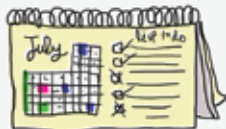
